AGNIVEER (GENERAL DUTY)

Education:

Class 10th /Matric pass with 45% marks in aggregate of five basic subjects and min 33% marks in each of those five subjects. For boards following grading system, grades commensurate to percentages, as above, will be considered.

AGE: 17½ - 21 Years

AGNIVEER (TECHNICAL)

10+2/Intermediate Exam Pass in Science with Physics, Chemistry, Maths and English with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 40% in each subject.

OR

10th/Matric pass with 50% in aggregate and minimum 40% in English, Maths and Science with 02 years of Technical Training from ITI or two/three years Diploma.

AGE: 17½ - 21 Years

AGNIVEER (CLERK / STORE KEEPER TECHNICAL)

10+2/ Intermediate Exam Pass in any stream (Arts, Commerce, Science) with 60% marks in aggregate and minimum 50% in each subject. Securing 50% in English and Maths/Accts/Book Keeping in Cl XII is mandatory.

AGE: 17½ - 21 Years

AGNIVEER TRADESMEN

Class 10th simple pass. No stipulation in aggregate percentage but should have scored 33% in each subject.

AGE: 17½ - 21 Years

AGNIVEER TRADESMEN

Class 8th simple pass. No stipulation in aggregate percentage but should have scored 33% in each subject.

AGE: 17½ - 21 Years

AGE CRITERIA : **Date of Birth:** Candidates born between **01 Oct 2004 to 01 April 2008** (both days inclusive) are eligible to apply.

PROCEDURE OF SELECTION

The recruitment process consists of **two phases**.

Phase-I : Online Common Entrance Examination (CEE)

- Computer Based Test (CBT)
- Objective MCQ
- Conducted in **13 languages**
- Questions:
 - **50 Questions – 1 Hour**
 - **100 Questions – 2 Hours** (depending on category)
- Marking:
 - Correct Answer → Full Marks
 - Unattempted → 0 Marks
- Agniveer Clerk candidates must qualify **Typing Test (30 WPM desirable)**.

Phase-II : Recruitment Rally

Candidates shortlisted in CEE will undergo:

1. Document Verification
2. Physical Fitness Test (PFT)
3. Physical Measurement Test (PMT)
4. Adaptability Test
5. Medical Examination
6. Final Merit List

Agniveer General Duty (Women Military Police)	Class 10th/Matric Pass with 45% aggregate marks in five basic subjects and minimum 33% marks in each subject.
Indian Gorkha Candidates	Class 10th Pass (Simple Pass).

Note:

- Candidates appearing in the **Class 10 Board Examination** are also eligible to apply, provided they produce the original marksheet during **Phase-II** of the recruitment process.

2. Age Criteria

- **Age: 17½ to 22 Years**
- **Date of Birth: 01 July 2005 to 01 July 2009** (Both dates inclusive)

Special Relaxation

- Widows of Defence personnel who died in harness: Upper age limit relaxable up to **30 years** (as on the date of joining training).
