## 1. Educational Qualification

Candidates must satisfy **any one** of the following:

### Option 1 – 10+2

- Qualified **10+2 (Intermediate)** with:
  - Mathematics
  - Physics
- From a recognized Board.
- Minimum **50% aggregate marks.**

### Option 2 – Engineering Diploma

- Three-year Diploma in Engineering in:
  - Mechanical
  - Electrical
  - Automobile
  - Computer Science
  - Instrumentation Technology
  - Information Technology
- Minimum **50% aggregate marks.**

### Option 3 – Vocational Course

- Two-year Vocational Course with:
  - Physics
  - Mathematics
- Minimum **50% aggregate marks.**

### Agniveer SSR 01/2027 Batch

- Born between **01 December 2004 and 31 May 2009** (Both dates inclusive)

### Agniveer SSR 02/2027 Batch

- Born between **01 May 2005 and 31 October 2009** (Both dates inclusive)

- Must have passed **Matriculation (Class 10)** from a Board recognized by the Ministry of Education, Government of India.
- Minimum **50% marks in aggregate**.
- Candidates appearing in the **Class 10 Board Examination (2025–26)** are also eligible to apply, provided they produce the original marksheet during later stages and secure the required marks.
